SWISS OPHTH- AWARD

A promotional award for young researchers in the field of the visual system and visual sciences. The Swiss Society of Ophthalmology SOG-SSO is responsible for content, organisation, and allocation of the award.

The award honours published papers covering basic and translational as well as clinical research related to the visual system. The SWISSophthAWARD offers three categories, with an award sum of CHF 10'000.– each:

- **best experimental work**
- **highest clinical relevance**
- **“Jury’s Choice”**

The expert jury consists of specialists (members of SOG-SSO) working in a wide range of ophthalmological fields. The awards are made available by the company Bayer (Schweiz) AG.

Application

Eligible are publications by researchers who are born after 15 May 1976, have a degree in natural sciences and are involved in research relevant to the ophthalmological disciplines. The researchers or work is required to have a connection to Switzerland (Swiss researcher, work carried out at a Swiss institution, etc.). Each author might submit one work per category. Publication date is restricted to 15 May 2018 until present, works accepted for printing permitted.
